He received his M.A. in Art History from Keio University and established Gallery KOKI ARTS in 2012 in Tokyo. While he is well versed in Japanese art, he also deals with contemporary art, introducing both well-known and young artists from his own unique perspective. He is also a member of ART FAIR ASIA FUKUOKA, the first art fair in Kyushu, and has participated in many domestic and international art fairs.


Examples of art galleries to visit.
